Nussloch, Germany, October 5th 2021- Pan African Health Systems Network (PAHESN), a not-for-profit organisation in Nussloch, Germany, represented by its Founder and Chief Executive Officer, Dr. Bernadette Ateghang-Awankem, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Saint Monica School of Health & Human Services (SMSHHS) Buea, Cameroon, and Health Research Foundation (HRF) Buea, Cameroon represented by Professor Sylvester Ndeso Atanga, to collaborate in increasing quality of evidence-based health systems strengthening research and implementation strategies.

Within the framework of this MOU, PAHESN, HRF and SMSHHS aspire to establish a Community Digital Health Hub to facilitate discussions on standardization processes and quality of digital health interventions for rural communities in Sub-Saharan Africa, serving as research and innovation hub.
